Free Bike Parts Swap!

New at the 5th annual Ride to Remember: Riders and non-riders are encouraged to bring good, clean bicycle parts and accessories that they'd like to give away at our Bike Park Swap!

Have you upgraded components or bought a part but never used it? There are many bicyclists who could use them! The Free Bike Part Swap will help you put those parts to good use.

- 1) Drop off parts outside the Ride's registration/check-in area after 6 a.m. on July 20.
- 2) If you want a part, take it to your vehicle as soon as possible. Volunteers will not hold parts.
- 3) Remaining parts will be moved to the finish area, where riders can again view and select items.
- 4) Take unclaimed parts home with you. After 4 p.m., remaining parts will be scrapped.

Because space is limited, please bring parts in cardboard boxes and put small items in bags.

What Can Be Swapped?

Components. Just about any type of bicycle part is welcome, from derailleurs to brake levers, from pedals to handlebars, and from tires to wheels.

Accessories. Accessories such as bells, racks, bags, and speedometers.

Apparel. Good, clean cycling apparel such as jerseys, helmets, shoes, and gloves.

Car Racks. Bicycle carriers for cars. These must be complete and fully useable. Please identify what cars they fit.

Broken, worn, and dirty parts will not be accepted. The swap is for good, working bicycle parts.

No money exchanged. All parts brought will be free to those who want them. Don't bring parts that you want to sell.
